## FOOD FOR THE REST OF US SPECIAL COMMUNITY SCREENINGS -- CANADA

Thank you for your interest in hosting a screening of *Food For The Rest of Us*! Below is some information about how it all works. After you've read this, please fill out our Screening Request Form.

Community Screening Licenses -- Available now with some exceptions!

Community screening licenses are intended for non-profits, charities, community groups, training institutions, professional associations, and government teams. Screening fees are for a one-time screening either virtually or in-person. Screening hosts may offer a free event or charge admission to cover costs. Screening fees will be determined based on anticipated audience size and organization type.

Small (up to 50 people): \$200 Medium (50-100 people): \$300 Large (100-200 people): \$500

All prices are in Canadian dollars, tax not included. Prices vary for corporate, for-profit groups.

Length of film: 83 min Language: English

*In-person screenings:* Digital download preferred, DCP and Blu Ray is possible. Shipping + Handling will be an additional charge.

*Virtual screenings*: a unique password protected watch webpage will be set up for each screening host with your organizational logo. Your watch webpage will provide your audience with the ability to stream the film on Vimeo and an option for them to link out to your Zoom webinar or meeting for your post screening discussion. The film can be made available to stream for up to 48 hours. If you want a screening window over 48 hours, an additional \$25/ week will apply up to two weeks. Pre-recorded host introduction videos can be added to film file for an additional \$75.

Multiple screenings: discounts apply for groups wishing to host three or more screenings!

Educational Screenings: at the moment, teachers, professors, librarians or student campus groups interested in hosting a one-off screening of Food For The Rest of Us can do so by filling out our <a href="Screening Request Form">Screening Request Form</a> and purchasing a Community Screening License. Starting in Spring 2022 the film will be available for educational purchase in Canada.

**Guest Speakers:** if you are interested in having one of the filmmakers, Caroline Cox or Tiffany Ayalik, participate in your post-screening discussion let us know via the screening request form. Speaker fees may apply.

**Accessibility + Subsidized Screenings:** We do not want to turn away any group interested in hosting a screening of *Food For The Rest of Us*. Without a question, we want this film to be accessible to all groups, barrier-free. In this regard, we are working on specific subsidized screening grant initiatives when and where we can. In the meantime, as independent filmmakers, we need to recoup our costs and keep the lights on plus industry standards require us to assign or license public performance rights (PPR).
